Purpose of the post:

The **PASONet IT Consultant** is sought to (i) review and identify the necessary information and communication technology platforms for PASO to support the delivery of technical and corporate management services; (ii) undertake the development of an IT strategy; and (iii) to support the roll-out of a "fit for purpose" IT hardware and software configuration that will cover all facets of PASO's connectivity and client interface with its Member States.

Minimum Qualifications and Experience Required but not limited to:

- Tertiary qualifications from a recognized institution in a relevant IT discipline
- Demonstrated experience, of at least ten (10) years in hands-on project and IT management roles;
- Experienced technology professional;
- Undertaken similar projects in a PI or developing nation context;
- Previous experience in World Bank funded projects or similar project management systems therein;
- Familiarity with international and/or donor-supported development project requirements will be an advantage;
